## 1. Members Present and Apologies

- a. Present: Cllr. T Daws, R. Lambourne, G. Nerney, Cllr. R Dawson (Chair)
- b. Apologies were received from: P. Frost, R. Crawford Cllr. GR Redford and Cllr. N. Morley.

## 2. Minutes of the previous meeting.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved by the meeting.

## 3. Play Equipment

### a. Nest Swing.

The Nest Swing had now been fitted with revised stainless steel fittings.

### b. Adult Equipment

The meeting was informed that Cllr. Redford had agreed to investigate Adult Equipment and report back to the Committee at a later meeting.

### c. Adventure Equipment.

Cllr. Daws reported that he had obtained quotes for various types of adventure type material as discussed at the last meeting.

- i. Concrete (Stanton) pipe: 2.5 metres x 1.05 metres – Delivered and sited £518.90 + VAT = £622.68.
- ii. Chesterfield Quarry: Sandstone ‘boulder’. The example size 4ft6” x 2ft 9” x 1ft 6” (3 tons) = £150 + VAT = £180.
- iii. The Committee decided to pursue the project by examining the number and siting of the pieces of equipment, the total cost of the project and potential funding routes.
